

## Discipline Policy Form

Each classroom has a behavior management system. If there is a re-occurring behavior problem that cannot be addressed with the classroom behavior system, a conference will be held with parents and a behavior program will be written to address the behavior.

Our enrollment criteria states that we are not the best setting for students whose primary barrier to learning is behavior based. We do not have the staff that is trained in this area and do not have the additional expertise with psychologists and social workers available. However, many times behavior difficulties exist due to a student's disability, language disorder, sensory issues, or as a result of frustration. Therefore, ACCESS Schools may choose to enroll a student with known behavior difficulties on a trial basis.

During this trial period, the school has the opportunity to work towards establishing more appropriate behavior. ACCESS Schools is committed to developing a plan for the school and the family to assist the student in establishing behavior that is more conducive to the classroom. However, ACCESS Schools reserves the right to dismiss a student and assist the family in securing a more appropriate setting.
